The exposure triangle is the most important consideration you will make when controlling your camera to shoot in manual mode or help making a decision about which Pre-programed setting to use.

If you're just starting out with digital photography, the three settings for perfect exposure – aperture, ISO and shutter speed – are what you need to understand to be on your way to better picture taking.

This workshop should give you a better understanding of how to take your photos under different lighting conditions to get the best results with your camera.
